9. At times people should do certain things that they might not necessarily enjoy. Is this a statement you are in agreement or disagreement with? Your answer should be supported with reasoning and examples.
10. Which is better - enjoying the money you earn as you get it or saving it for the future? Provide supporting examples along with your reasons.
11. You recently heard that the community you live in may be getting a new high school, which is yet to be built. Is this a plan you would oppose or support? Please give the reasons for your thinking along with relevant examples.
